King of Chicago is a strategic board game of 1930s gangsters in, of course, the city of Chicago. It has everything you can possibly imagine from that era: drive-by shootouts, corrupt police and cement shoes. You start out as a little fish with a car, a fistful of dollars and your turf. Then you build your up own gangster empire of speakeasies, casinos and brothels until you can be crowned King of Chicago.



The first game from Danish publisher Tusbas, **King of Chicago** is highly atmospheric, using contemporary photographs to illustrate the cards used in the game and having neat Thirties-style cars as playing pieces. As well as cars and cards, the game contains various cardboard markers, plastic building pieces, paper money, a couple of dice and, of course, a board.
